Solution

The addition of shock and algaecide on a regular basis will be more effective at preventing algae growth than treating algae once it is visible in a pool. However, if mustard algae does appear, follow the steps below for treatment:

- Step 1** Adjust the pH to 7.2 - 7.4.
- Step 2** Brush the entire pool surface.
- Step 3** Add [poolife® Mustard Algae Treatment](#)
- Step 4** Shock the pool with [poolife® TurboShock® shock treatment](#) or [poolife® Rapid Shock® shock treatment](#).
- Step 5** Run the filter continuously, brushing and vacuuming frequently until the algae is gone.
- Step 6** Chemically clean the filter with [poolife® Filter Cleaner](#).
- Step 7** If algae remains a problem, contact your authorized poolife® Dealer for further directions.

NOTE – If you continue to experience algae, despite a high chlorine reading, the pool water may contain too much stabilizer (cyanuric acid) which interferes with the efficiency of the chlorine. Ensure you are following responsible pool care by shock-treating with a poolife® calcium hypochlorite-based shock product and contact your authorized poolife® Dealer for further directions.
